 ESTIMATED TO BE IN NEIGHBORHOOD OF TWENTY THOUSAND PERSONS. SOURCE
 FURTHER ADVISES UNCONFIRMED REPORTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED OF
 POSSIBLE ATTEMPTS TO DISRUPT CONCERT AND CAUSE VIOLENCE
 IN AREA BY UNKNOWN PERSONS, POSSIBLY BY SOME OF THOSE INVOLVED
 IN DISRUPTION OF CHICAGO GRANT PARK ROCK CONCERT JULY TWENTYSEVEN
 SEVENTY. SOURCE FURTHER ADVISED THAT RAVINIA PARK AREA
 WAS TO BE HEAVILY PATROLED BY SOME TWO HUNDRED POLICE OFFICERS
 INCLUDING ONE HUNDRED ILLINOIS STATE POLICE AND OFFICERS FROM
 NEARBY COMMUNITIES.

Enclosed for the Bureau are ten (10) copies of an LHM concerning the captioned affair.

On 9/3/69, [redacted] (protect by request), [redacted] New York City, furnished by mail to the NYO the contents of the LHM. The report from [redacted] was included in the LHM in its entirety so as to portray a concise and accurate viewpoint as observed by [redacted].

[redacted] is characterized as an individual who voluntarily furnishes information to the FBI with whom contact has been insufficient to determine reliability.

The LHM is classified "~~Confidential~~" because data reported by the source, if disclosed, could result in the identification of a confidential source of continuing value and compromise his future effectiveness. Such compromise could be detrimental to the defense interests of the nation.

Entertainers at the festival included the following, Joan Baez, Arlo Guthrie, Tim Hardin, Ritchie Havens, the Incredible String Band, Ravi Shankar, Sly and the Family Stone, Bert Sommer, Sweetwater (Friday, August 15). Keef-Hartley, the Canned Heat, Credence Clearwater, the Grateful Dead, Janis Joplin, the Jefferson Airplane, Mountain, Quill, Santana, The Who (Saturday, August 16); The Band, Jeff Beck Group, Blood, Sweat and Tears, Joe Cocker, Crosby, Stills and Nash, Jimi Hendrix, the Iron Butterfly, Ten Years After and Johnny Winter (Sunday, August 17). But these were only the entertainers named on the program; the main entertainment (if that is the correct word) was provided by the bizarre people present, one with another and the non-publicized groups, chief of which was a group known as The Quarry, performing away from the main stage, before an audience of an estimated ten thousand.
